Nauru Utilities Corporation is advising the general public that the Airport Ring Road opposite the weather station to Ella Park will be closed for all motorists during the following periods:

- 5.30pm-11.00pm on Wed, 10Jun2020
- 5.30pm-11.00pm on Thurs, 11Jun2020

The full closure is arranged to allow NUC engineers to construct underground cables trenches and carryout cable laying works.

The travelling public is advised to take this notice into account and use alternative routes when finalising their travel plans in and around Yaren District.

Demand for water across Nauru has risen to critical levels and continues to rise to over 1.2 million litres per day.

As a result, NUC requests everyone to work together to conserve water.

Your cooperation and efforts to minimise your water use will allow NUC to continue to provide timely supply of water to you during this prolonged drought period, without interruption to your water service.

Temporary cessation of some water sales (see below for details)

NUC has temporarily ceased the sale and delivery of water for the following purposes, to align with water conservation practices:

- Filling swimming pools
- Washing boats and vehicles
- Watering playfields, lawns and all outdoor surfaces

Your cooperation is needed and all users are urged, wherever possible, to defer activities which may require a large volume of water consumption.

These restrictions are due to the current drought conditions and your drinking water systems' sensitive water source.
