PhD scholarships: Australia Pacific Security College. Closes 31Aug2020 (see attached).

The Australia Pacific Security College, funded by Australia's DFAT as part of the Pacific Step-up, has released four PhD scholarships for students from PIF countries (excluding Australia and New Zealand) for study at the ANU.

The scholarships provide funding for postgraduate students to pursue a 3 year PhD program relevant to the 2018 Boe Declaration on Regional Security.

Applications close on 31 August 2020. The ANU will take into account individual circumstances, including as they relate to current travel restrictions, when assessing applications.

The scholarship includes the following benefits:

- Tuition fees
- Stipend
- Health care cover
- Dependent child allowance
- Relocation reimbursement
- Thesis allowance
- Fieldwork and conference support.
