NATIONAL DISASTER RISK MANAGEMENT ACT 2016

CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) TRAVEL RESTRICTIONS

Order No. 04 / 2021

Effective 19th October 2021

PURSUANT to the powers vested in me under the *National Disaster Risk Management Act 2016*, **I, Hon. Lionel Rouwen Aingimea, M.P.**, Minister for National Emergency Services, do hereby **ORDER** that:

(1) A person travelling to Nauru is required to spend a minimum of fourteen (14) days in any of the following countries or territories prior to travelling to Nauru:

(2) For the avoidance of doubt and until further notice, no person shall travel to Nauru, if within the 14 days prior to travel, the person has spent any time or transited through:

- (a) Fiji;
- (b) Papua New Guinea; and
- (c) any of the following States or Territories of Australia;
 - (i) Australian Capital Territory;
 - (ii) New South Wales; and
 - (iii) Victoria.
