

Furthermore, in August 2021, we formalized in Suva, Japan's new assistance worth 2.5 million Australian dollars for the procurement of heavy machinery to enhance waste management services in Nauru. Currently, Japan, Australia and the United States are committed to working in partnership with Nauru, Kiribati and the Federated States of Micronesia to improve internet connectivity by providing funding to build a new undersea cable.

Through mutual cooperation, Nauru has become one of the closest partners of Japan in the Pacific. The achievements at the PALM9 have helped elevate Japan-Nauru relations to a higher level. I will follow up on Japan's commitments made at the PALM9 with you, Excellency, to the best of my ability.
