- 1. The House met at 10 a.m. pursuant to adjournment.

3. **Election of Speaker**

The Deputy Speaker again informed the House that before it proceeds to the despatch of its business there are still vacancies as shown on the Notice Paper and accordingly called for nominations for the position of Speakership first.

4. Statement From the Chair

The Chair commented on the current stalemate of the House since its first sitting after the elections and being drawn to his attention on the relevancy of Article 16(b) of the Constitution of Nauru, and to enable him to seek legal advice on the matter, the House was suspended until 2 p.m. in the afternoon.

The Chair apologised for the lengthy delay in resuming since its suspension, for want of legal advice from the Justice Department, but was now content and encouraged that the matter in question, Article 16(5), will now be referred to the Supreme Court as advised to the Chair by the President.
