

## Expression of Interest sought for appointment as Judge to the Supreme Court of Nauru

The Government of Nauru seeks expressions of interest from persons suitably qualified under Part V of the Constitution of Nauru to be appointed as judges of the Supreme Court of Nauru. The Supreme Court conducts a wide range of business in fields including land law, criminal law, civil law, migration law and constitutional law. Candidates should ideally have extensive experience in senior judicial positions.

The Supreme Court currently conducts four circuits a year for sessions up to 21 days. The number and length of sessions is likely to increase. Judges would be expected to sit as circuit judges on at least one occasion each year. The Government will consider appointment of up to three judges.
