Drink-driving blitz is on

Nauru Police Force is conducting random breath testing as part of their drink-driving blitz.

There is no such thing as safe drink-driving. If you are drinking or are planning to drink, **DO NOT** ride a motorbike or drive a car.

Drinking alcohol severely affects your ability to ride and drive, endangering your life as well as your friends and families' lives.

You will be breath tested and your blood alcohol concentration (BAC) must be under 0.05 per cent to ride or drive.

Two (2) standard drinks in the first hour will raise your BAC to 0.05 per cent.

One (1) standard drink per hour after that will keep you at 0.05 per cent blood alcohol level.

How much is a standard drink?

- can of beer = 1.3 standard drinks
- 30ml nip spirits = 1 standard drink
- vodka mixers 355ml = 1.2+ standard drinks

Plan your drinking:

Don't ride or drive:

- stay with a friend or family overnight
- call a family member or friend to come and get you —it's more important you get home safely

Avoid risky situations:

- don't ride or drive if you have been drinking
- don't get on a friend's bike or car if they have been drinking

Keep Nauru safe.
