# **EXEMPTION OF THE COMMONWEALTH BANK OF AUSTRALIA**

# SL No. 21 of 2025

**PURSUANT** to the powers vested in me under *Regulation 72* of the Anti-Money Laundering and Targeted Financial Sanctions (Financing of Terrorism and Proliferation Financing) Regulations 2023 ('Regulations'), I, Lionel Rouwen Aingimea, M.P., Minister for Justice and Border Control, in consultation with the Cabinet affirmed by Cabinet resolution of 15<sup>th</sup> May 2025 hereby **EXEMPT** the **Commonwealth Bank of Australia** from the requirements of the Regulations.

EXEMPTION is granted on the basis that the Cabinet is satisfied that the Commonwealth Bank of Australia is adequately:

- (a) regulated under anti-money laundering and combatting financing of terrorism and proliferation financing laws of Australia; and
- (b) supervised by the relevant authorities of the Commonwealth of Australia.
