**PASSPORTS (NAURU ECONOMIC AND CLIMATE RESILIENCE  
CITIZENSHIP FORMS AND FEES) REGULATIONS 2025**

**SL No. 26 of 2025**

Notified: 19<sup>th</sup> May, 2025

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The Cabinet makes the following Regulations under Section 57 of the *Passports Act 2011*:

**1 Citation**

These Regulations may be cited as the *Passports (Nauru Economic and Climate Resilience Citizenship Forms and Fees) Regulations 2025*.

**2 Commencement**

These Regulations commence on the date they are notified in the Gazette.

**3 Application for ordinary Nauruan passport**

(1) For the purpose of Section 7 of the Act, an application form for an ordinary Nauruan passport shall be in Form 1 of Schedule 1 for a person granted citizenship under the *Nauru Economic and Climate Resilience Citizenship Act 2024*.

(2) An application under subregulation (1) shall be accompanied by the following:

- (a) Certificate of Citizenship issued under the *Nauru Economic and Climate Resilience Citizenship Act 2024*;
- (b) 2 recent passport size photographs, one of which is to be certified at the back of the photograph, by a Commissioner for Oaths or Notary Public;
- (c) certified copy of the bio-page of the passport, if the applicant is a citizen of and has a passport of the country where he or she is permanently residing;
- (d) an identification document or certificate with photograph issued under a written law of any other country, which may include driver's licence or national identity card;
- (e) in case of renewal of a passport, the biodata page of the expired or current passport; and
- (f) such other information which the Secretary deems necessary.

**4 Information which must be contained in Passport issued**

A Nauruan passport issued under these Regulations shall include the following details:

photograph;

secondary photograph showing as watermark;

passport type;

the Republic's issuing code of 'NRU';

passport serial number, for an ordinary Nauruan passport – the letters 'NN' followed by 6 numerals:

surname;

given names;

nationality;

date of birth;

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gender;  
place of birth;  
date of issue;  
date of expiry;  
issuing authority; and  
signature of holder.

## **5 Cancellation of travel document**

For the purposes of Section 24 of the Act, the notice cancelling a travel document issued under these Regulations shall be in Form 2 of Schedule 1.

## **6 Notice for lost or stolen travel document**

For the purposes of Section 33 of the Act, a notice for a lost or stolen travel document by the holder of the travel document shall be given to the Secretary in Form 3 of Schedule 1.

## **7 Passport photograph requirements**

A passport photograph submitted under these Regulations shall have the following specifications:

- (a) be 4.5 centimetres x 3.5 centimetres;
- (b) have adequate brightness and contrast;
- (c) have natural skin tone;
- (d) have a close up of the head, ears and partial shoulders;
- (e) straight looking, centred with neutral expression;
- (f) the face shall be in sharp focus and clear with no ink marks, creases or lines;
- (g) the face, from forehead edge to bottom of chin, shall be seventy to eighty percent of the photograph;
- (h) the eyes shall be open and no hair obstructing the face;
- (i) prescription glasses, if worn, shall be clear and thin framed and should not have flash reflection or obscure the eyes;
- (j) head coverings, hair, head-dress or facial ornaments shall not obscure the face;
- (k) the photograph shall have plain light background;
- (l) there shall be no other person or object in the photograph;
- (m) the lighting shall be uniform with no shadows on the face or behind;
- (n) photograph shall not have red eyes;
- (o) photograph with adequate digital resolution; and
- (p) shall be no more than 3 months old.

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## **8 Register of travel documents**

- (1) The Secretary shall keep and maintain a separate register of all travel documents issued under these Regulations.
- (2) The register shall include:
  - (a) the date of issue and expiry of each passport;
  - (b) all the information submitted under Regulation 3;
  - (c) all the information under Regulation 4; and
  - (d) any other information as the Secretary deems necessary.
- (3) For the purposes of Section 56 of the Act, the Register may be kept as set out in Schedule 2, in accordance with Regulation 9.

## **9 Record keeping requirements**

- (1) The Secretary shall keep a record of all matters required to be registered.
- (2) The records shall be kept and maintained in:
  - (a) electronic form or digital form; and
  - (b) manual Register or in case of electronic or digital form, capable of being re-produced in printed form.
- (3) The Secretary shall keep and maintain the records for an indefinite period.
- (4) The Secretary shall not disclose or share information with any third party except where it is required for a law enforcement agency, for any other official purpose, by the Republic or any proceedings.
- (5) Any information provided to the Republic under these Regulations, shall not be disclosed to any other person without the prior consent or approval of the Secretary, except where the information is required as exhibits or evidence in court.

## **10 Fees**

The fees payable under these Regulations are under Schedule 3.

**TAKE NOTICE** that your travel document is cancelled forthwith due to:

- ☐ Section 7(1) of the Act, you are not a Nauruan citizen and I am not satisfied with your identity;
- ☐ Section 15(1) of the Act, each person who has parental responsibility for the child has not consented to the child travelling internationally
- ☐ Section 16(a) of the Act, a warrant for your arrest is in force in Nauru in relation to a serious offence against a law of Nauru
- ☐ Section 16(b) of the Act, you being prevented from travelling internationally under a law of Nauru or an order or other direction made under a law of Nauru
- ☐ Section 24(2)(a) of the Act, I intend to issue another passport to you immediately after cancelling the passport
