1 Citation

These Regulations may be cited as the *Referendum Procedures (Amendment of the Schedule) Regulations 2025.*

2 Commencement

These Regulations commence on the date they are notified in the Gazette.

Note for Voters

For the purposes of voting in this Referendum, the Parliament has passed the *Constitution (Amendment) Bill 2025* to extend the term of Parliament from 3 to 4 years. This Bill can only become law if two thirds of the votes cast in the referendum are in favour of it. The Bill is to extend the current term of Parliament from 3 to 4 years. As a voter you have to answer the question below. The sample of how to vote on whether you agree or disagree with the extension of the term from 3 to 4 years is provided below.
